EXCEL AT WORK WHILST ENJOYING *ISLAND LIFE*

Migrate your office, carry your borderless business or job and join a global community of nomads whilst enjoying all that Malta has to offer.

If you're a non-EU, non-EEA and/or non-Swiss national of good conduct, who can prove you work remotely and earn a minimum yearly gross income of €42,000, you're eligible to apply for the Nomad Residence Permit.

APPLICATION *PROCESS*



Gather Documents

You will need to share a valid travel document, evidence of employment status, latest 3-month bank statement showing proof of income and a police conduct certificate. A health insurance and proof of accommodation will only be needed after your approval. Full details in our document checklist and our Frequently Asked Questions on our website. We urge you to read these thoroughly so you are well informed of all details. General requirements for obtaining visas and similar permits apply.



Submit Application

Submit application via a dedicated portal on our website, together with supporting documentation and receive instructions for payment. The process is straightforward.



Application Review

We will verify the submitted documents, conduct background checks and notify you by email with a decision letter once the process is complete.



Pick Up Nomad Residence Card

If you are successful, you will be invited to proceed to Malta. Follow the instructions given on the approval letter to conclude your application.

Residency Malta Agency is the government entity responsible for managing and promoting residency programmes for third-country nationals, including Malta's digital nomad visa, the Nomad Residence Permit. These programmes offer residency in a safe and stable jurisdiction, with business opportunities, access to top-notch education and health care, while enjoying a Mediterranean lifestyle. All applications undergo thorough due diligence to ensure that only fit-and-proper individuals are granted residency.
